# Why Empower Girls?

- Society benefits when girls have equal access to opportunities.
- Girls have the right to make choices on life decisions including education, career and physical/sexual health.
- Empowering girls through education can break the cycle of poverty in families.
- Gender parity is needed in various career fields including STEM, sports, politics and business.



## Statistics On Canadian Girls

- Girls under 17 yrs. represent 9.4% of Canada's total population and 18.7% of Canada's female population.



- **About 4 in 10 girls living with a lone parent are in a low-income situation.**
- More than 8 in 10 girls ages 12 to 17 report a strong sense of belonging to their local community.
- Girls more likely to report liking school a lot at age 11, but more likely to feel pressured by school work at ages 13 and 15.



- **Positive peer relationships constitute an important source of support, contribute to sense of belonging, and are associated with higher feelings of self-esteem.**



## Our Founder

**Hon. Dr. Jean Augustine  
P.C., C.M., O.Ont., C.B.E.**

Hon. Dr. Jean Augustine P.C., C.M., O.Ont., C.B.E. is the first African-Canadian woman to be elected to the House of Commons. She was elected in the riding of Etobicoke-

Lakeshore in 1993 and sat in Parliament until 2006. During this time, she served as Parliamentary Secretary to the Prime Minister, Minister of State and Deputy Speaker.

Among Hon. Dr. Augustine's many achievements and honours includes leading the motion that allowed for the placement of the Famous Five statue on Parliament Hill in Ottawa, and the motion that created Black History Month in Canada.

In June 2014, the Hon. Dr. Jean Augustine opened the doors of the Jean Augustine Centre for Young Women's Empowerment (JAC). The registered charity was created to address a specific need in the Etobicoke-Lakeshore community for a space where young women and girls could thrive and be supported to reach their full potential.

Since its opening JAC has expanded its scope to support young women and girls across Canada. We take a holistic approach to empowerment by providing programs that support the mental, physical, and social wellbeing of young women and girls.

## Support Development & Sustain Growth
